ANECHOMAI

'Ana' - up;
'Echomai' - to hold on.
It means to 'to hold up
against a thing, to bear
with, to endure.'



'kakus' - evil; 'pascho' - to suffer. It means 'to sustain or endure evil afflictions.'



HUPOMENO

'hupo' -under, 'meno' - to remain. It means 'to remain under, to endure or sustain a load of miseries, adversities, persecutions in faith and patience.



It means 'to bear from underneath, to undergo hardship.'



It means: 'to endure patiently, to be longsuffering.' Exercising understanding and patience toward persons and relatioships.



KARTEREO

It means: 'to be strong, steadfast, firm, to endure, hold out, bear the burden.'
